- Ensuring that no action will be taken against any employee who discloses a safety concern through the hazard reporting system, unless such disclosure indicates, beyond any reasonable doubt, an illegal act, gross negligence, or a deliberate or wilful disregard of regulations or procedures as per our Just Reporting Culture policy and process;
- Continuous improvement in safety performance, efficiency of operations and service delivery to our customers;
- Complying with, and, where practicable, exceeding legislative and regulatory requirements and standards;
- Providing all the resources necessary to support this policy and the System for Safety Management.
